GOD'S GRACE PT 5 JESUS, GOD'S PROVISION OF GRACE.

Grace is God's loving provision for the physical, spiritual and emotional needs of all mankind.

Titus 2:11-12 NKJV For the grace of God that brings salvation **has** appeared to all men, 12 teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age,

Romans 5:17 NKJV For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.)

Romans 5:21 NKJV so that as sin reigned in death, even so **grace** might reign through righteousness to eternal life through **Jesus Christ our Lord.**

John 1:17 NKJV For the law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.

John 14:6 NKJV Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

Acts 4:12 NKJV Nor is there salvation in any other, for there **is no other name** under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."

Hebrews 10:5 NKJV Therefore, when He came into the world, He said: "Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, **But a body You have prepared for Me.**

Luke 1:35 NKJV 35 And the angel answered and said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God.

John 12:23-24 But Jesus answered them, saying, "The hour has come that the Son of Man should be glorified. 24 Most assuredly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it produces much grain.

1 Peter 1:23 NKJV having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the **word of God** which lives and abides forever,

1 John 2:2 EXB He ·died in our place to take away [is the atoning sacrifice for] our sins [his death pays the penalty and removes God's anger from us; 4:10; Rom. 3:25; Heb. 2:17], and not only our sins but the sins of all people [the whole world].

2 Corinthians 5:21 NKJV For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

Hebrews 7:25 NKJV Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.

1 Corinthians 15:22 NKJV For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive.

James 3:9 MEV With it we bless the Lord and Father, and with it we curse men, who are **made in the image of God.**

2 Corinthians 5:21 KJV For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be **made the righteousness of God in him.**

Romans 8:2 NKJV For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.

Romans 8:16-17 TPT That evening the people brought to him many who were demonized. And by Jesus only speaking a word of healing over them, they were totally set free from their torment, and everyone who was sick received their healing! 17In doing this, Jesus fulfilled the prophecy of Isaiah: He put upon himself our weaknesses, and he carried away our diseases and **made us well**.

Colossians 2:9-10 AMPC For in Him the whole fullness of Deity (the Godhead) continues to dwell in bodily form [giving complete expression of the divine nature]. 10 And you are in Him, made full and having come to fullness of life [in Christ you too are filled with the Godhead—Father, Son and Holy Spirit—and reach full spiritual stature]. And He is the Head of all rule and authority [of every angelic principality and power].

Ephesians 2:8-9 NKJV For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.

Romans 4:16 NKJV **Therefore it is of faith that it might be according to grace**, so that the promise might be sure to all the seed, not only to those who are of the law, but also to those who are of the faith of Abraham, who is the father of us all

Romans 5:2 NKJV through whom also we have **access by faith into this grace** in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

Mark 11:24 NKJV Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you **receive them**, and you will have them.
