2 Peter 1:3 NKJV as His divine power **has given** to us all things that pertain to **life** and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue,

Ephesians 2:8-9 NKJV For by grace you **have been saved** through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, 9 not of works, lest anyone should boast.

Matthew 28:18-20 NKJV 18 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Genesis 1:26 TLB Then God said, "Let us make a man—someone like ourselves, to be the master of all life upon the earth and in the skies and in the seas."

Genesis 1:27-28 NKJV So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. 28 Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have **dominion** over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living that moves on the earth."

Psalm 115:16 NKJV The heaven, even the heavens, are the Lord's; **But the earth He has given to the children of men.**

Psalm 8:4-6 TPT Why would you bother with puny, mortal man or care about human beings? Yet what honor you have given to men, created only a little lower than Elohim, crowned with glory and magnificence. You have delegated to them rulership over all you have made, with everything under their authority, placing earth itself under the feet of your image-bearers.

Hebrews 11:3 TPT Faith empowers us to see that the universe was created and beautifully coordinated **by the power of God's words!** He **spoke** and the invisible realm gave birth to all that is seen.

Psalm 89:34 NKJV My covenant I will not break, Nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips.

Genesis 12:2 NKJV I will make you a great nation; I will bless you and make your name great; and you shall be a blessing.

Romans 4:17 NKJV 17 (as it is written, "I have made you a father of many nations") in the presence of Him whom he believed—God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did;

Genesis 17:1-6 NKJV When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the Lord appeared to Abram and said to him, "I am Almighty God; walk before Me and be blameless. 2 And I will make My covenant between Me and you, and will multiply you exceedingly." 3 Then Abram fell on his face, and God talked with him, saying: 4 "As for Me, behold, My covenant is with you, and you shall be a father of many nations. 5 No longer shall your name be called Abram, but your name shall be Abraham; for I have made you a father of many nations. 6 I will make you exceedingly fruitful; and I will make nations of you, and kings shall come from you.

Exodus 3:9-12 9 Now therefore, behold, the cry of the children of Israel has come to Me, and I have also seen the oppression with which the Egyptians oppress them. 10 Come now, therefore, **and I will send you** to Pharaoh that you may bring My people, the children of Israel, out of Egypt. 11 But Moses said to God, "**Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh, and that I should bring the children of Israel out of Egypt?"** 12 So He said, "**I will certainly be with you.** And this shall be a sign to you that I have sent you: When you have brought the people out of Egypt, you shall serve God on this mountain."

Exodus 7:1-2 So the Lord said to Moses: "See, I have made you as God to Pharaoh, and Aaron your brother shall be your prophet. 2 You shall speak all that I command you. And Aaron your brother shall tell Pharaoh to send the children of Israel out of his land.

Exodus 7:16-19 **And you shall say to him,** 'The Lord God of the Hebrews has sent me to you, saying, "Let My people go, that they may serve Me in the wilderness"; but indeed, until now you would not hear! 17 Thus says the Lord: "By this you shall know that I am the Lord. Behold, I will strike the waters which are in the river with the rod that is in my hand, and they shall be turned to blood. 18 And the fish that are in the river shall die, the river shall stink, and the Egyptians will loathe to drink the water of the river." 19 Then the Lord spoke to Moses, "Say to Aaron, 'Take your rod and stretch out your hand over the waters of Egypt, over their streams, over their rivers, over their ponds, and over all their pools of water, that they may become blood. And there shall be blood throughout all the land of Egypt, both in buckets of wood and pitchers of stone.'

Exodus 7:20 **And Moses and Aaron did so, just as the Lord commanded.** So he lifted up the rod and struck the waters that were in the river, in the sight of Pharaoh and in the sight of his servants. And all the waters that were in the river were turned to blood.

Psalm 105:26-28 TPT 26 But he sent them his faithful servant, Moses, the deliverer, and chose Aaron to accompany him. 27 **Their command** brought down signs and wonders, working miracles in Egypt. **28 By God's direction, they spoke** and released a plague of thick darkness over the land.

Exodus 14:13-16 And Moses said to the people, "Do not be afraid. Stand still, and see the salvation of the Lord, which He will accomplish for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall see again no more forever. 14 The Lord will fight for you, and you shall hold your peace." 15 And the Lord said to Moses, "Why do you cry to Me? Tell the children of Israel to go forward. 16 But lift up your rod, and stretch out your hand over the sea and divide it. And the children of Israel shall go on dry ground through the midst of the sea.
