GOD'S GIFT OF UNBROKEN FELLOWSHIP

Genesis 1:26 NKJV Then God said, "Let Us make man in **Our image**, according to **Our likeness**; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."

Genesis 2:7 NKJV 7 And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils **the breath of life;** and man became a **living being.**

1 Thessalonians 5:23 NKJV Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify[a] you completely; and may your whole **spirit**, **soul**, **and body** be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Genesis 2:16-17 NKJV And the Lord God commanded the man, saying, "Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat; 17 but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die."

John 3:16 NKJV For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have **everlasting life**.

2 Corinthians 5:21 NKJV For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

Colossians 2:14-15 TPT He canceled out every legal violation we had on our record and the old arrest warrant that stood to indict us. He erased it all—our sins, our stained soul—he deleted it all and they cannot be retrieved! Everything we once were in Adam has been placed onto his cross and nailed permanently there as a public display of cancellation.

2 Corinthians 5:17 NKJV Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

John 3:5-6 NKJV 5 Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is **born of water and the Spirit**, he cannot enter the kingdom of God. 6 That which is born of the **flesh is flesh**, and that which is born of the **Spirit is spirit**.

John 14:20 NKJV At that day you will know that I am in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you.

1 Corinthians 6:17 NKJV But he who is joined to the Lord is one spirit with Him.

John 14:16 NKJV And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may **abide with you** forever—

Hebrews 10:12 But this Man, after He had offered **one sacrifice for sins forever**, sat down at the right hand of God,

2 Corinthians 5:19 GW In other words, God was using Christ to restore his relationship with humanity. He didn't hold people's faults against them, and he has given us this message of restored relationships to tell others.

Hebrews 10:17-18 then He adds, **"Their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more."** 18 Now where there is remission of these, there is no longer an offering for sin.

Romans 6:1 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin that grace may abound?

Romans 6:2-4 Certainly not! **How shall we who died to sin live any longer in it**? 3 Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? 4 Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, **that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.**

1 John 3:18-21 My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, but indeed and in truth. 19 And by this we know that we are of the truth, and shall assure **our hearts before Him.** 20 **For if our heart condemns us,** God is greater than our heart, and knows all things. 21 Beloved, **if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence toward God.**

Matthew 13:15 NLT For the hearts of these people are hardened, and their ears cannot hear, and they have closed their eyes— so their eyes cannot see, and their ears cannot hear, and their hearts cannot understand, and they cannot turn to me and let me heal them.'

Galatians 5:22-23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

Mark 10:19 You know the commandments: 'Do not commit adultery,' 'Do not murder,' 'Do not steal,' 'Do not bear false witness,' 'Do not defraud,' 'Honor your father and your mother.'"

Acts 2:44-47 Now all who believed were together, and had all things in common, 45 and sold their possessions and goods, and divided them among all, as anyone had need. 46 So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart, 47 praising God and having favor with all the people.
