

STEWARDED GOD'S GRACE PT2

Romans 5:17 NKJV For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness **will reign in life** through the One, Jesus Christ.)

Genesis 1:27-28 NKJV So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. 28 Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

Hebrews 11:3 TPT Faith empowers us to see that the universe was created and beautifully coordinated by the power of God's words! He spoke and the invisible realm gave birth to all that is seen.

Exodus 7:1-2 So the Lord said to Moses: "See, I have made you as God to Pharaoh, and Aaron your brother shall be your prophet. 2 You shall **speak all that I command you**. And Aaron your brother shall tell Pharaoh to send the children of Israel out of his land.

Psalms 105:26-28 TPT 26 But he sent them his faithful servant, Moses, the deliverer, and chose Aaron to accompany him. 27 **Their command** brought down signs and wonders, working miracles in Egypt. 28 **By God's direction, they spoke and released a plague of thick darkness over the land.**

Hebrews 1:3 CSB The Son is the radiance of God's glory **and the exact expression of his nature**, sustaining all things by his powerful word. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high.

John 4:34 NKJV Jesus said to them, "My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to finish His work.

John 3:16-17 NKJV For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. 17 For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be **saved**.

Luke 4:43 NKJV But He said to them, "I must preach **the kingdom of God** to the other cities also, because for this purpose I have been sent."

1 John 3:8b For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.

Philippians 2:7 AMP but emptied Himself [without renouncing or diminishing His deity, but only **temporarily giving up the outward expression of divine equality** and His rightful dignity] by assuming the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men [**He became completely human** but was without sin, being fully God and fully man].

John 3:2 NKJV This man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, "Rabbi, we know that You are a **teacher** come from God; for no **one** can do these signs that You do unless God is with him."

Acts 10:38 NKJV how God **anointed Jesus of Nazareth** with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

John 14:10-11 NKJV Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? **The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works.** 11 Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father in Me, or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves.

John 8:28 NKJV Then Jesus said to them, “When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am He, **and that I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father taught Me, I speak these things.**”

John 5:19 NKJV Then Jesus answered and said to them, “Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, **but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner.**”

Luke 4:31-32 KJV And came down to Capernaum, a city of Galilee, and taught them on the sabbath days. 32 And they were **astonished** at his **doctrine**: for his **word was with power.**

Luke 5:15 NKJV However, the report went around concerning Him all the more; and great multitudes came together **to hear, and to be healed** by Him of their infirmities.

Luke 6:19 NKJV And the whole multitude sought to **touch Him, for power went out from Him and healed them all.**

Matthew 9:29-30 29 Then He touched their eyes, saying, “According to your faith let it be to you.” 30 And their eyes were opened.

Luke 4:33-36 NKJV 33 Now in the synagogue there was a man who had a spirit of an unclean demon. And he cried out with a loud voice, 34 saying, “Let us alone! What have we to do with You, Jesus of Nazareth? Did You come to destroy us? I know who You are—the Holy One of God 35 **But Jesus rebuked him, saying, “Be quiet, and come out of him!”** And when the demon had thrown him in their midst, **it came out of him and did not hurt him.** 36 Then they were all amazed and spoke among themselves, saying, **“What a word this is! For with authority and power He commands the unclean spirits, and they come out.”**”

Luke 4:38-39 NKJV 38 Now He arose from the synagogue and entered Simon’s house. But Simon’s wife’s mother was sick with a high fever, and they made request of Him concerning her. 39 So He stood over her and **rebuked the fever, and it left her.** And immediately she arose and served them.

Luke 5:12-13 NKJV And it happened when He was in a certain city, that behold, a man who was full of leprosy saw Jesus; and he fell on his face and implored Him, saying, **“Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean.”** 13 Then He put out His hand and touched him, saying, **“I am willing; be cleansed.”** Immediately the leprosy left him.

Matthew 8:5-9 When Jesus arrived in Capernaum, a Roman army captain came and pled with him to come to his home and heal his servant boy who was in bed paralyzed and racked with pain. 7 “Yes,” Jesus said, **“I will come and heal him.”** 8-9 Then the officer said, “Sir, I am not worthy to have you in my home; and it isn’t necessary for you to come. **If you will only stand here and say, ‘Be healed,’ my servant will get well!** I know, because I am under the authority of my superior officers and I have authority over my soldiers, and I say to one, ‘Go,’ and he goes, and to another, ‘Come,’ and he comes, and to my slave boy, ‘Do this or that,’ and he does it. **And I know you have authority to tell his sickness to go—and it will go!**”
